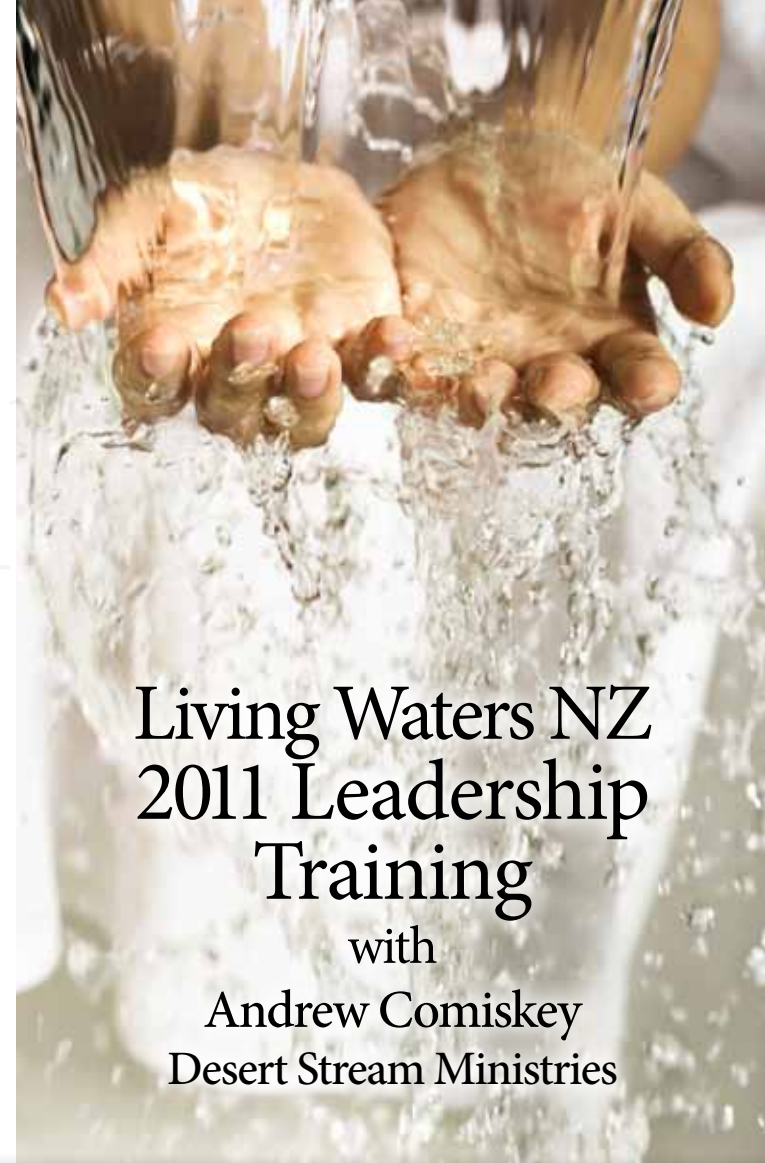

What is Living Waters?

Living Waters is an in-depth, Christ-centred programme for people seeking healing in areas of sexual and relational brokenness. A healing, teaching and discipleship series, Living Waters addresses the reality that we are all broken in our ability to love others well. The goal of Living Waters is to lay a foundation for sexual and relational wholeness in our lives. Through the worship, teaching, prayer, and small groups of Living Waters we learn about:

- God's powerful love for us and how Jesus is central to our hope for wholeness
- The power of the cross to restore our soul, sexuality, and relationships
- The process of walking out our healing and taking our place in the church

Why Get Trained?

The main emphasis of our time together will be personal healing for you. It's as we learn to enter into the healing process together that we can learn how to heal others. Just as each Living Waters group is a place for deeper healing, so we as leaders will be enabled to lead others into healing ministry as we share with one another the experience of being set free in the depths of our souls. Training is required in order to be a group coordinator.

Who is Eligible?

The Living Waters Training is available to those in leadership, whether that leadership be in healing ministry, an existing Living Waters group, or a pastoral position. People seeking to further their own healing are also welcome.

What's Taught?

Participants will become familiar with the Living Waters programme and its 20 lessons found in the Living Waters: Pursuing Sexual and Relational Wholeness in Christ guidebook. The Leadership Training Seminar equips men and women for effective ministry to the sexually and relationally broken. It is an intensive training, including a shortened experience of the Living Waters program with small group participation as well as practical instruction.

Workshops will be taught on a variety of issues such as:

- Effective Prayer Ministry
- Understanding and praying for the healing of sexual abuse and sexual addiction
- Releasing Living Waters into your church



This year we welcome Andrew Comiskey, the founder and international director of Desert Stream Ministries and Living Waters. Andy has been a Vineyard Pastor, and ministers extensively to the sexually and relationally broken. Andy is married to Annette and they have 4 children.



Rev. Ron Brookman is the Director of LW Australia and serves on the LW International Council. Ron pastors a church in Sydney. Ron is married to Ruth, and is the father to 5 children.



Helen Harris is the Director of LWNZ, and has been involved with LW for 17 years.

Living Waters seeks to convey Jesus, "full of grace and truth," (John 1:14) into our brokenness. We provide help by imparting healing to the sexually and relationally broken, through biblical wisdom, godly support, and the power of prayer. We help the broken to stand in Jesus Christ as their hope and source of healing. We also help them to find their place in the body of Christ, so that their healing can grow into a blessing for others.
